Forthcoming Elections

As many of you will be aware there will be a requirement at the forthcoming elections for all those attending polling stations to bring approved photo ID with them. This change is being introduced nationally – it is not a West Suffolk Council decision. Between 6th February – 10th March members of the elections team at WSDC will be making visits to residents to help them get registered to vote. Staff will be clearly identifiable and if there is no reply when they call they will leave a calling card, printed on pink for visibility, clearly setting out the deadline for registering to vote.
