- DC/21/2305/HH Two storey rear extension; flue to outside elevation, relocation of solar panels at Saddler's Cottage, Wickham Street.

Business Support

The Government has recently announced a COVID-19 Additional Relief Fund (CARF) to help businesses that have not previously been eligible for rate relief during the pandemic. The fund will support councils in delivering a local discretionary scheme. We will be going through the Government guidance and modelling a scheme to distribute the rate relief to those businesses that need it the most and who have not already been helped. Our aim is to implement this business rate relief to businesses ahead of the business rates annual billing in March.
