Wickhambrook Neighbourhood Plan Working group meeting 7.00 to 9.00 pm Monday 6 June 2022 NOTES

1: Attendance:

2: Minutes of previous meetings

- We agreed these as a fair record
- Richard to send minutes from May meetings to Hilary for website
- There were no matters arising

3: Feedback from Jubilee Picnic Sunday 5 June

- Most people who visited our stand seemed not to know about either the Preferred
 Options consultation or West Suffolk's proposal for housing numbers and a site in
 Wickhambrook our presentation therefore generated a lot of interest
- There was some confusion arising from the circulation of a flyer about a site near the school proposed by the landowners although this site has been deferred by West Suffolk and is therefore not eligible for consideration under Preferred Options
- There seemed to be broad acceptance of the proposed figure of 40 houses to be built over 20 years – but many people expressed concerns about whether existing infrastructure (roads, sewerage, school, health centre etc) could cope with more houses
- People also seemed to acknowledge the merits of West Suffolk's proposed site –
 although there were concerns about the status of any revised settlement boundary
 and whether there might be 'creeping development' beyond it in time
- Many people emphasised the importance of screening, landscaping and the provision of gardens and green spaces within any development scheme

4: Putting the consultation online from 6 to 23 June

- We noted that the link to West Suffolk's Preferred Options virtual exhibition is now on Facebook
- We agreed to post online the consultation materials essentially as used at the picnic
- The main text will go on the Parish Council website with a link to the questions on Survey Monkey
- Tracey will write an introduction for Survey Monkey and check what format the materials need to be in
- Richard will prepare the main text and turn the questions where possible into 'yes
 no' or multiple choice questions

5: West Suffolk's Preferred Options workshop

- Tracey will attend this online workshop on our behalf
- We noted that Wickhambrook should remain a Local Service Centre

- We noted that any formal response to the proposed site and number of houses will be premature at this stage
- Tracey will try to locate West Suffolk's landscape appraisal paper for us to look at

6: The Design Guidance and Codes

- We reviewed and discussed comments received so far
- We agreed that the Design Code draft is essentially a good document that captures the character of the village well
- We noted in addition to previous comments that it would be good to include more summer pictures showing leaf cover on trees and hedges
- Richard to send amended group comments and Roger's comments to AECOM together with our consultation materials and West Suffolk's proposal for a development site under Preferred Options
