Multi-Use Games Area

Our Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) was damaged in the storms over the May Bank Holiday. We are looking at options to either repair or replace it. It may also be an opportunity to look at upgrading the games surface.

Current Situation:

Quotes were sought for both repair/refurbishment or replacement with new boundary fencing/boarding. There was concern that the boarding was likely to continue to deteriorate, and the structure become less secure more sections of boarding were taken down. Additionally, there was concern that the sections of boarding removed to ground level could still pose a health and safety risk, particularly has it had not been possible to completely exclude members of the public from the area, despite active messaging both on site and on the website.

At its July meeting the parish council decided that all the boarding would need to be cleared and any holes arising from post removal made good. The preference was to do this by means of a working party, with the boarding removed off site and stored for possible future recycling. For these reasons, following the Estates Committee meeting on 5th August (Report **WPC.** as <u>WPC.EC.21.08.05</u> and **Min. EC.21.08.12** refer), a working party was organised and the boarding removed to a skip for recycling by West Suffolk at a cost of £298.30.

Future Options:

At the Community Engagement Day on 3rd July there were a number of requests for smaller football goals with nets. Other requests included the provision of a 3G Astro turfed area and outdoor table tennis table(s). Outdoor Gym Equipment was also popular as part of further development of the Six Acres and Recreation Ground, and this has been raised in previous consultations with residents.

The clerk was asked to look into quotes and report options to the Estates Committee, for future consultation with the parish as part of preparing a grant funding bid, which could also cover new equipment at the skate park, and the outdoor gym equipment.

Subsequent to the meeting, the site was measured (11m x 13m).





The nearest size MUGA identified is 11 x 15m steel, at £14,600 plus 28 hours installation

In view of the limited space available for the installation of a Multi-Use Games Area on that site, the Estates Committee at its August meeting considered:

• Bounding the site with low level fencing

- Re-purposing the site for outdoor gym equipment, which could:
 - a. Meet an identified demand in the parish supported by evidence from the community engagement day, previous meetings and anecdotal request
 - b. Fit with a demand for and move to more outdoor fitness facilities generated by the recent pandemic,
 - c. Provide an opportunity to link into existing fitness classes based at the Memorial Social centre; and
 - d. Bring the space back into use in the short to medium term, with
- Development of new and larger grant funded MUGA, incorporating 5 aside football hockey and basketball, in a new position at the southern most point of Six Acres. This would allow for a MUGA up to 20m x 30m.

The Estates Committee was however concerned about possible noise nuisance to residents of Thorns Close in this position. Another issue subsequently identified was the likely need for substantial hard landscaping in this position, and possible drainage issues which might impact on the tennis courts.

Consequently, following advice from a specialist play area provider, when an indicative quote was sought for a new, larger Multi Use Games Area, the North East Corner of Six Acres was considered more appropriate, with less risk of noise nuisance or drainage issues.



An indicative quote for a new MUGA at this location is attached as **Appendix A**

Action:

Councillors are asked to indicate whether they support the Estate's Committee's proposal for future options to redevelop the old MUGA space for outdoor fitness equipment and research and consult on the development of a new MUGA.

Re-development of Old MUGA space:

There are a range of options for outdoor fitness stations which could be sited within the old MUGA space.



Dependant on the style of fitness equipment and range, it may be that a re-surfacing of the area be considered (particularly if the range of equipment decided upon includes free-fall opportunities). The most cost-effective solution, which could bring the space back into use with outdoor fitness stations in a more timely manner, would be to limit the choice of equipment within the MUGA space to low level (below 600mm) cardiovascular equipment which therefore requires no safety surfacing beneath it. The equipment conforms to EN16630 specification (this is the safety standard for outdoor gym equipment).

In this way, there would be no need to re-surface or replace the existing tarmac. The suggested equipment shown above would accommodate up to thirteen users at any one time.

An additional Timber Gym Station, designed for body weight exercises, dips, pull ups, presses etc could also be sited just outside of the fenced area.



Hilary Workman Clerk & RFO September 2021 An indicative quote from Playforce (\pounds 15,072.10 plus VAT) based on this option is attached as **Appendix B.** Playforce has offered the whole project (including supply and installation of new bow top fencing to bound the area at a discounted to \pounds 19,600 plus VAT.

There is funding for the Teen project replacement in earmarked reserves (\pounds 12,500) which could form the basis of seed funding for a larger grant application.

Action:

Councillors are asked to indicate whether they support the proposal above to research, consult on and apply for grant funding to re-purpose the old MUGA space for:

- low level cardiovascular equipment, with no requirement to re-surface the existing tarmac; and
- An additional Timber Gym Station, which could be sited just outside of the fenced area.

If Councillors agree to the proposal above:

Fencing in of the existing MUGA

Three quotes have been requested based on bow top fencing (of a similar style to the skate park), at varying heights of 1m, 1.2m and 2m, including self-closing child safe gate for the area, attached as **Appendix C** to this report.

The parish council has power to undertake this work under Public Health Act 1875, s.164. There are earmarked reserves of \pounds 12,750, part of which the parish council could determine to use to fund this work (which could then form part of the parish contribution to the larger project).

The parish council has worked with Playforce on two previous projects. Their quote includes removal and disposal of the basket ball hoop to ground level and re-use of the eastern entrance through provision of staggered bow top fencing, allowing for access to an additional Gym Timber Gym Station in the future.

Recommendation:

The parish council authorise the cost of works £ to the old MUGA space on Six Acres to include:

- i. Removal and disposal of a basket ball hoop at Ground level £ 112.50
- ii. Undertake repairs to damaged tarmac area £ 654.37

iii. Supply and install Green Bow Top fencing to a height of 1.2m £4269.80 iv. Delivery £212.55

At a total cost of £5249.22 plus VAT, undertaken by Playforce, and approve the transfer of £5,250 from earmarked reserves (Teen Project Replacement) to General Reserves.

There is an opportunity to apply for funding coming up through West Suffolk's Community Chest (last submission date 29th October 2021), and the clerk is looking for other match funding opportunities. Additionally, Playforce offer a free of charge funding service (where either the parish council agrees to proceed with that company if a funding application is successful, or the bid is unsuccessful).

Hilary Workman Clerk & RFO September 2021 The autumn could be used to consult with residents of the parish about the type of equipment that would be best suited for a re-purposing of the area and development of a new MUGA, building engagement and an understanding of costs. A Graffiti workshop is planned for the October half term, and this could double as an opportunity for community engagement and consulting on options for the outdoor gym, MUGA and new equipment at the skate park.

The November meeting of the parish council could then be used to consider a business case for the proposals and delegate authority to the clerk to apply for grants.

The December meeting of the Estates Committee could then be used to finalise proposals to be included in a grant application, having considered the responses from consultation questions and the engagement day at the skatepark in October.

A grant funding bid would therefore be likely to include:

- Re-purposing the Multi-use games area for outdoor fitness, including:
 - New low level cardiovascular equipment and
 - A Timber Gym with safer grass matting just outside the old MUGA space
- New equipment to replace grind rails in the skatepark (and consider replacement of half and quarter pipe surfaces based on professional advice
- Development of a new Multi-Use Games Area, possibly at a site in the North-east corner of Six Acres; and
- New bow top fencing for both the cemetery road and bury road play areas.

Action:

Councillors discuss and agree a proposed timescale for developing the project, and whether or not to include a proposal for new bow top fencing at Cemetery and Bury Road Play parks.

Recommendation:

The parish council delegate the clerk to submit any appropriate grant applications to attract funding for the development of the re-development of the old MUGA space for outdoor gym equipment.
