
Multi-Use Games Area

Our Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) was damaged in the storms over the May Bank Holiday. We are looking at options to either repair or replace it. It may also be an opportunity to look at upgrading the games surface.

Quotes have been sought for both repair/refurbishment or replacement with new boundary fencing/boarding. The only quote received so far has been for the clearing of the existing boarding from the site, at a cost of £2100 plus VAT from Eastern Play Services Ltd (attached as Appendix A to this report) who state that the Games Area is not safe in its current state. The most recent report from the play inspector (9th June '21) is summarised below:



The area is likely to continue to deteriorate, and the boarding cannot be left in situ as this is likely to represent a risk of itself.

At the Community Engagement Day on 3rd July there were a number of requests for smaller football goals with nets, which could be achieved if the seating was taken out and now boundary fencing installed. Other requests included the provision of a 3G Astro turfed area and outdoor table tennis table(s). Outdoor Gym Equipment was also popular as part of further development of the Six Acres and Recreation Ground.

At its July meeting the parish council decided that all the boarding would need to be cleared and any holes arising from post removal made good. The preference was to do this by means of a working party, with the boarding removed off site and stored for possible future recycling.

The clerk was asked to look into quotes and report options to the Estates Committee, for future consultation with the parish as part of preparing a grant funding bid, which could also cover new equipment at the skate park, and the outdoor gym equipment.

Subsequent to the meeting, the site was measured $(11m \times 13m)$.



The nearest size MUGA identified is 11 x 15m steel, at £14,600 plus 28 hours installation



In view of the limited space available for the installation of a Multi-Use Games Area on that site, it has been suggested that the Estates Committee and Parish Council consider:

- Bounding the site with low level fencing
- Re-purposing the site for outdoor gym equipment, which could:
 - a. Meet an identified demand in the parish supported by evidence from the community engagement day, previous meetings and anecdotal request
 - b. Fit with a demand for and move to more outdoor fitness facilities generated by the recent pandemic,
 - c. Provide an opportunity to link into existing fitness classes based at the Memorial Social centre; and
 - d. Bring the space back into use in the short to medium term, with
- Development of new and larger grant funded MUGA, incorporating 5 aside football, hockey and basketball in a new position near the tennis courts, with possible shared use by the school





A range of outdoor fitness equipment to be sited in the existing MUGA space. There are a range of options:



Dependant on the style of fitness equipment and range, it may be that a re-surfacing of the area be considered (particularly if the range of equipment decided upon includes free-fall opportunities).

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There is funding for the Teen project replacement in earmarked reserves (£12,500) which could form the basis of seed funding for a larger grant application.

There is an opportunity to apply for funding coming up through West Suffolk's Community Chest (last submission date 29th October 2021), and the clerk is looking for other match funding opportunities.

The summer could be used to consult with residents of the parish about the type of equipment that would be best suited for a re-purposing of the area and development of a new MUGA, building engagement and an understanding of costs.

The September meeting of the parish council could then be used to consider a business case for the proposals and delegate authority to the clerk to apply for grants.

The October meeting of the Estates Committee could then be used to finalise proposals to be included in a grant application, having considered the responses from consultation questions and the engagement day at the skatepark in September.

A grant funding bid would therefore be likely to include:

- Re-purposing the Multi-use games area for outdoor fitness, including:
 - New fitness equipment
 - o Re-surfacing if needed
 - o Fencing of the area, if not completed in advance
- New equipment to replace grind rails in the skatepark (and consider replacement of half and quarter pipe surfaces based on professional advice
- Development of a new Multi-Use Games Area, possibly at a site adjacent to the Tennis Courts

And could also include new bow top fencing for both the cemetery road and bury road play areas.

Action:

Councillors discuss and agree on a route forward for development of Outdoor fitness, replacement equipment at the skatepark and new site for MUGA.

Fencing in of the existing MUGA

Three quotes have been requested based on bow top fencing (of a similar style to the skate park), at varying heights of 1m, 1.2m and 2m, including self closing child safe gate for the area, including, where possible, removal of existing boarding and posts, attached as Appendix A to this report.

The parish council has worked with Playforce on two previous projects. Once approved, the work could be delayed until such time as it has been established whether or not a new surface would be required, or a new surface could be inset within the area, with a boundary of wood chippings (for example).

The parish council has power to undertake this work under Public Health Act 1875, s.164. There are earmarked reserves of £12,750, which the parish council could determine to use to fund this work (which could then form part of the parish contribution to the larger

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project). Transfer of funds from earmarked reserves to the general reserve would then need to be authorised by the parish council at its September meeting.

Recommendation:

Identify the preferred option for replacement bow top fencing, installation, removal of existing boards and posts based on quotes attached as Appendix A for referral to the parish council for costs to be authorised.


