Suggested action: complete form on behalf of WPC with following Comments: How do you feel about the loss of wildlife in your area? <i>The household Survey which formed the initial canvass of views of residents of the parish demonstrated a strong concern that wildlife and their environment should be protected.</i> Why is it important for development to work in harmony with nature? <i>Development proposals should avoid the loss of, or substantial harm to, trees, hedgerows and other natural features such as ponds and watercourses. Where such losses or harm are unavoidable:</i> <i>i. the benefits of the development proposal must be demonstrated to clearly outweigh any impacts; and</i> <i>ii. suitable mitigation measures, that provide better replacement of the lost features will be required to achieve measurable biodiversity net gain.</i> Why is the natural environment important to you and your community? <i>The natural environment contributes to the physical and mental good health of residents of he parish, contributes to sustainability and mitigates the impact of climate change.</i> And post an item to the website inviting residents to complete the online questionnaire for Suffolk Wildlife Trust</p>
