# Review of Specification for Grounds Contract in Wickhambrook 2023/24

The Estates Committee reviewed the specification for the grounds contract for 2024-25 at its July '23 meeting, which was subsequently approved by the parish council (**Mins.EC.23.07.12 & 23.07.16**), noting that the parish council would continue on the basis of annual contracts, which provide for flexibility and allow for ongoing review of the specification.

At its November '23 meeting, the Parish Council appointed TOP Garden Services to undertake the grounds contract for the 2024/25 financial year (**Min. 23.11.16 refers**).

The first cut took place in March, and the service attracted some negative comments through the early part of the season, although this has improved since July.

One of the specific issues which could be addressed through the contract specification is the type of mower used for the larger grassed areas (specifically Recreation Ground and Six Acres). Details of the cuts included in the contract are set out at **Appendix A.** This currently specifies:

The contractor should have sufficient equipment to allow the grass to be maintained under all weather conditions. In particular they will need a flail or a gang mower so that the cuttings are not generally visible

The previous contractor operated with a combination of cylinders and flail mowers with decks between 2 - 3.5m, operating with rollers to provide a more professional finish.

Adjustments to the 24/25 specification, which included:

- inclusion of access to the Bury Road Pocket Park
- splitting out the cutting in the cemetery to take account of spring flowers were helpful in providing clarity and allowing for flexibility.

The clerk identified the following adjustments to the contract for the Estates to consider including in the next specification:

- Allow for reduction of cuts on Tennis Court Banks to make provision for the protection of bee orchids in the banks (reduction to 8 cuts per year);
- Reduce cuts of Inner and Outer Banks to once a year developing these as wildlife areas
- Dedicating specific areas of greens, churchyard and cemetery to wildlife, with appropriate signage, and reducing cut in these areas to once per year following seed setting (there would be an initial cost in durable notices).
- Increase cuts at MSC to 18 per year (consistent with Recreation Ground, Six Acres and other areas).
- Reduce cuts of footpaths to 4 per year
- Reduce brush cut of concrete pad at Six Acres to 1 per year.

The estates committee, and subsequently the parish council, considered these proposed changes to the grounds contract specification in their July meetings (**Mins WPC.EC.24.07.11 & WPC.24.07.15 refer**), and two consultations have been carried out (one a poster display at Wickhambrook Fete and Flower Show, and latterly in August, a survey on Survey Monkey, the results of which are attached as **Appendix B**).

Comments (although not statistically relevant) supported the inclusion of wildlife areas, which was also identified by a much greater proportion of respondents throughout the surveys undertaken for the preparation of the Neighbourhood plan. A general reduction in the number of cuts was not supported (although references to reduction in cuts related only to footpaths).

Accordingly, the clerk updated the draft specification with respect to the 2025/26 season, which was presented to the Estates Committee at their September meeting (Report **WPC.EC.24.09.03** and Min. **WPC.EC.24.09.11** refer). Noting:

- Respondents to the survey were supportive of Wildlife areas
- Concerns relating to reduction in cuts related only to footpaths, of which the parish council is only responsible for FP25 & 26;
- The PCC had asked that All Saints Church not be included as a wildlife area
- The parish council should explore the planting of wildflower seed to support the wildlife areas

the committee asked the clerk to forward the proposed specification (excluding All Saints Church as a Wildlife Area) to the next parish council as set out at Appendix D of report WPC.EC.24.09.03. Revisions to the proposed Wildlife areas are set out at **Appendix C**.

The cost of wildlife seed may be built into the budget for the next financial year, together with necessary signage for wildlife areas.

This revised specification is attached as **Appendix D** to this report, and plans at **Appendix E**.

Action: Determine approach to cuts for the next cutting season (2025/26) with a final specification to be approved by the parish council at its September meeting.

Costs have risen year on year, and one of the ways we have been trying to offset these is by reviewing the contract each year, and being more flexible about when and how often certain areas are cut.

For example, over the past two years, we have delayed cuts in the old cemetery to allow time for wildflower seeds to set, and this year we have delayed cuts to the





# COMMUNITY ACTION 2 WILDLIFE AND CONSERVATION

The Parish Council will work with the Wickhambrook Estates Committee and interested parishioners in order to sustain and

improve the natural environment in and around the village.

Actions to be considered will include:

- conserving trees and hedgerows, initially by carrying out an audit of assets,
- protecting green spaces and woodlands and enhancing their value for wildlife,
- working with landowners to promote take-up of stewardship schemes, including:
  - a) opening up permissive paths,
  - b) fostering wildflower mixes on field margins, and
  - c) promoting biodiversity by establishing wild areas, wildlife habitats and wildlife corridors around the Parish.

# Wickhambrook 700 Parish Council

Your Estates Committee has identified some further adjustments which could be made to the contract specification for the next year (2025-26):

- 1. Allow for reduction of cuts on Tennis Court Banks to make provision for the protection of bee orchids in the banks (reduction to 8 cuts per year);
- 2. Reduce cuts of Inner and Outer Banks to once a year developing these as wildlife areas
- 3. Consider either
  - a. No Mow May in specified areas (Smaller greens where visibility not an issue, churchyard and part cemetery); or
  - Dedicating specific areas of greens, churchyard and cemetery to wildlife, with appropriate signage, and reducing cut in these areas to once per year following seed setting

(there would be an initial cost in durable notices)

- 4. Increase cuts at MSC to 18 per year (consistent with Recreation Ground, Six Acres and other areas).
- 5. Reduce cuts of footpaths to 4 per year
- 6. Reduce brush cut of concrete pad at Six Acres to 1 per year.

Some of these options could promote biodiversity and wildlife habitats, and at the same time reduce costs, allowing the parish council to divert resources to other activities.

We plan to carry out a full consultation over the summer, before making a final decision on the grounds contract at the September meeting, but would like to hear your thoughts today on these proposals—please jot a few thoughts on a post it note and add it to the comments sheet on this board.
