Commemorative Works for D-Day 80

The 80th Anniversary of the Normandy Landings falls on 6th June this year, with a series of major commemorations and events across the UK and France.

In 2020 the parish council ordered and installed a WW2 Bench Seat (sited in the cemetery, near the War Memorial) to mark the 75th Anniversary of the end of the second world war following consultation with the History Society.



It has since been brought to the attention of the parish council that the bench doesn't reference either the Royal or Merchant Navy, and as there are a number of Wickhambrook residents interred in the cemetery who served in the Royal or Merchant Navy, there have been a number of requests that the parish council address this going forwards. The anniversary of the Normandy Landings is an opportunity to do so.

One option initially considered was whether to add a plaque to the existing bench, but this could be difficult to attach.

The clerk has identified two benches (both from the same supplier, Ogilvie Memorial Benches), attached as Appendix A, which might be suitable for the cemetery.

The Council's financial regulations require that when entering into contracts for the supply of goods, materials or specialist services (other than those excepted under 11.1.a), the Clerk or RFO shall strive to obtain 3 estimates where the value is below £3,000. There was only one other comparable style of commemorative bench in this instance, from Black Country Metalworks. Requests for quotes for cleaning of the Memorial were sent out to five businesses, of whom to date only Abbey Memorials has responded.

The War Memorial in the Cemetery was last professionally cleaned and re-pointed in 2020 as part of the commemoration of VE75.

A quote for the cost of cleaning the memorial is attached as Appendix B and a further e-mail confirmation of price has been received from IMI at a cost of £2075 plus VAT.

The parish council's relevant powers are:

Local Government Act 1972, s.214(2) - to provide and maintain cemeteries in or outside the council's area; and

s.111 of the Local Government Act 1972 - to do anything that will facilitate, be conducive to or incidental to the discharge of its powers and functions.

The council has £3500 its approved budget for 2024-25 for Cemetery and Memorial Refurbishment, which anticipated the likely cost(s) of both the Memorial Bench and the cleaning of the War Memorial. The additional costs for plaques, fixings and delivery could be funded through Services and Supplies (£750.00).

Action:

The Estates Committee chose a preferred bench to commemorate the contribution of the Royal and Merchant Navy.

Recommendation

The committee authorise:

- i. the purchase of a WW2 Memorial Bench Seat as specified above at a cost of not more than £1741 plus VAT; and
- ii. the cost of cleaning the War Memorial in advance of DDay80 at not more than £2000 plus VAT.

Councillors are also asked to consider if they would wish to have an opening ceremony for the bench and invite residents of the parish and former serving members of the RN or MN.
