Interim Inspection of Parish Trees and Recommended Works

At its meeting in July '24, the Estates Committee meeting considered a proposal to undertake work to trees in the parish cemetery (previously circulated as WPC.EC.24.07.04) and noting the likely costs, agreed that formal quotes should be requested once the full report on the Tri-annual inspection of parish trees was available.

The Tri-annual inspection of the Parish Trees by Acacia Trees was completed in June 2024 and following their report and relevant quotes, the Estates Committee resolved:

- i. The Estates Committee authorise work to Parish Trees at a cost of not more than £800 plus VAT; and
- ii. The Estates Committee authorise work to Cemetery Trees at a cost of £1120 plus VAT and ask the parish council to authorise a drawdown from Earmarked Reserves of £1300 from Cemetery & Churchyard.

(Min. 24.09.10). This work was instructed in the autumn, with the majority having been completed in December '24 (some minor works to be completed late January). In the course of undertaking these works, the appointed Tree Surgeon has identified a number

and in the course of has highlighted a number of additional areas where work should or could be considered, namely:

- 1. The grinding out of the stumps in the cemetery (and two further stumps in Six Acres), for which a quote has been provided at **Appendix A**
- The pollarding of two Yews to the right of the path to the Chapel of Rest to 2 metres (Appendix B - highlighted green)
- 3. Work to Yew T20a, on the boundary of the Cemetery and Footpath, which is large and blocks out a lot of light and access to memorials below it
- 4. Work to the Chestnut Tree T19 in the corner of the cemetery which has boughs entangling with the power cable running to the Chapel of Rest, and heavy boughs extending out over Cemetery Road¹.
- 5. Possible further work to one yew to right of the path to the Chapel of Rest (pollard to 2 metres) and three Yews to left of the path to the Chapel of Rest

Plans and images of the proposed trees are attached as **Appendix C.**

Acacia Tree Surgery are additionally offering:

- Interim assessment of parish trees, noting only any work required (f.o.c); or
- Interim assessment of parish trees with full record of each tree assessed at £175.00

Powers:

- Public Health Act 1875 s.164 to provide and maintain land for public recreation;
- Local Government Act 1972, s.214(2) to provide and maintain cemeteries... and
- Open Spaces Act 1906, ss.9 & 10 to provide and maintain ... or burial ground

Funding:

Cemetery & Churchyard - £660.50 against a budget of £1000 Six Acres - £100 against a budget of £500 Tree Surgery - £80 against a budget of £2550

And in 2025–26 - Tree Surgery: £750

Action:

Decide whether to instruct Acacia to undertake:

- a) Interim assessment in 2025, at a cost of £175; or
- b) Interim assessment free of charge, noting only those trees which require work

Recommendation:

The Estates Committee authorise works to parish trees as set out at 1 & 2 above, at a cost of not more than £520


